

What is Aviators?

Aviators is the after school program at the Fuller Middle school which encompasses a variety of activities directed at art, music, physical fitness and project based lessons to help extend learning from the school day. Students will come together for snack and homework help, as well as a variety of clubs and workshops. At the end of the day, students will close with small group advising and team-building activities.



How many days does Aviators run?

Aviators runs Monday - Thursday from 2:30 - 5:00 and has 3 ten week sessions that run in the fall, winter and spring. **We start our first session on Monday, September 25th.**

Is Aviators run by FPS staff?

Some FPS staff run clubs and we also get outside vendors to help with other activities. We like to partner with the businesses and people of Framingham to give them a connection with the youth of our community.

How many days do students need to attend?

In order to be in this program, we need students to attend at least **2 days** to the program. If the student has other obligations on a particular day, we ask that someone notify the coordinator, Ken Borter, so we know of their absence from the program.

Is there a fee?

As of now, there is no fee to join the program.

Do students have to attend all year?

Students do not need to attend all year long to participate in the program. However, they do need to commit to the full 10 weeks if they sign up for a session. If a student has a sport or another activity that begins in the winter but ends in the spring, they can always just not sign up for the middle session. If you have questions regarding dates, please feel free to ask!

Can I do Drama and Aviators?

It depends! We would suggest that students who are interested in both talk to the Drama teacher or director of the play and the after school coordinator to make sure it is possible.

Is transportation provided?

Transportation is available for students who typically take the bus. If a student needs to take the bus, it needs to be known by the coordinator before 10am of the day the transportation is needed.

Are students expected to do homework after school?

The expectation for students coming to Aviators is that there is some academic time. Students are given the opportunity to do homework, but it is not forced. If a student does not have and/or want to do homework during the time that is given, we ask that they engage in an academic activity such as studying for tests and quizzes, reading a book of their choice or practicing skills needed in the classroom. If students are not engaged in doing that, then students may not be able to participate in clubs/activities later in the afternoon.
